



## FORGIVING GRACE

#### Mysterious joy:

However, the world has a particular destructive character. Matt 27:36 "And sitting down they watched him there". These 7 words have been the subject of endless meditations among believers. The Roman soldiers along with the Jews watched Jesus die on the cross. They all knew who was on the cross and for what reason. It was Jesus, the Messiah, he was there because of the Jews. (For he knew that because of envy they had handed Him over, Matt. 27:18). The man on the cross was not a convicted criminal but a good man. He healed many, raised the dead, and opened the eyes of the blind. And they knew that once he is dead, they lose any possibility of benefitting from the miracles and wonders, but still the feeling in side them was that of ecstasy. They enjoyed the sight when they finally got Jesus up on the cross. It seems that they did feel the joy of killing.

Do believers too enjoy this kind of satisfaction in seeing the destruction of someone else? This is mere human nature; envy is a part of man. Most often envy originates from very trivial reasons; sometimes silly and inconsequential. A preacher can't stand another preacher, an elder can't stand another elder, and a deacon can't stand another deacon and so on. Instead of building up, envy causes us to attempt to destroy each other for some mysterious joy.

Often, we fight and struggle to conquer envy and keep it suppressed so that it does not become obvious. But even then, when the opportunity comes, the serpent raises its head. Inconspicuous may be the action, a suggestion or a remark, a reaction, but it is the dormant envy that makes men do that. The same dormant envy takes the form of hatred, and we become unforgiving in the course of time. If we do not

have the kind of love and hence the forgiving grace in us, it will be the envy and hatred that is going to govern most of our attitudes and actions. In the story of Cain and Abel, they were not strangers or enemies, but were brothers by blood. Envy becameanger, then hatred and culminated in the first murder of human history (Gen. 4:8).


#### Fellowship in suffering:

"Rejoice with them that rejoice and weep with them that weep", Romans 12:15. In other words, cry with those who cry and celebrate their joy with those who are joyful. It is not easy. Some feel the joy only when they see their near neighbor or friend, or brother suffer or falter in their steps. They do not feel the joy until their heads are inclined or stooping. It is almost impossible to rejoice with those who are rejoicing and to cry with those who are crying.

Americans are prudent in avoiding contact with people when they are infected with some communicable disease such as common flu. We are often very self-centered, cruel, and selfish. But in Zechariah 13:6 we read about the wounds, our savior received from the house of his friends. "And one will say to him, what are these wounds between your arms? Then he will say those with which I was wounded in the house of my friends." He did not hesitate to come near us and we belong to the one who gave himself for many.

Many a times, people are not only unforgiving, but they try to hurt others knowingly by doing some thing or making somederogatory remarks deliberately. It is comparable to the behavior of the honey bee. It stings with all its might and what it inflicts is a small prick but the honey bee falls down and dies. The person who hurt others gets more deeply hurt, sometimes even fatally.

#### LESSON 2

# UNITY: SO WHAT IS THE BIG IDEA?



**Daniel Walker** 

KEY CONCEPT: An effective sermon will have one BIG idea that holds the entire sermon together. The BIG idea of the sermon should always come from the biblical text. The BIG idea is a clear simple sentence that expresses what the sermon is about.

#### WHAT IS THE BIG IDEA OF A SERMON?

By now, it should be clear that a sermon will be effective when it has **one BIG idea**. Remember a sermon is not about 2 or 3 things loosely joined together.

An effective sermon will have **one BIG idea** that holds the entire sermon together.

RULE 1 – The **BIG idea** of the sermon should come from the biblical text.

We can now give two simple rules to help us with the **BIG idea**.

Donald G. Miller says:

"Every sermon should have a theme, and that theme should be **the theme of the portion of Scripture on which it is based**."13

Gary Miller and Phil Campbell say:

"Expository preaching happens when the message of the text = the message of the sermon." 14

The word **expository** means – intended to explain or describe something. **Expository** preaching seeks to **explain** or **describe** the biblical text to the listeners can understand and obey it. Expository preaching starts by studying the text to discover the message of the biblical text which then becomes the **BIG** idea of the sermon. Good preaching is always **expository**.

In the Old Testament we have a clear example of **expository** preaching when Nehemiah gathered God's people to hear God's Word.

"They [the priests] read from the Book of the Law of God, making it clear and giving the meaning so that the people understood what was being read." (Nehemiah 8:8)

Notice the **expository** work of the priests:

- 1. They read the Bible to the people.
- 2. Then they made it **clear** and **gave the meaning**. In other words, they helped people understand what they were reading.
- 3. The outcome is powerful. "Then all the people went away to eat and drink, to send portions of food and to celebrate with great joy, **because they now understood** the words that had been made know to them." (Nehemiah 8:12)

Good preaching will always attempt to expose, explain, clarify and give the meaning of the biblical text to the listeners so that they can understand the words and know how to obey.




Figure 3: The path of an expository sermon





# BREAK THE SILENCE OF DOMESTIC ABUSE

o community, no society, and no country are immune to domestic violence. This family violence continues despite passing various Domestic Violence Acts and laws and setting up shelter homes and medical facilities. How can we stop this? Whose responsibility is it to stop this? The community should wake up to the terrific effects of abuse, and support groups like parents, pastors, church elders and so on, should respond in the right way to the horrors of domestic violence. The Church should not be silent but respond compassionately to the cries of the victims and provide help and shelter. The history of domestic violence has been a history of silence because many do not realize the seriousness of this issue and also feel uncomfortable to discuss intimate partner violence as they feel it is a personal problem and hence it is better to ignore it than to deal with it. There are also many misconceptions like who is at fault? Why did the victim stay so long? Who triggered it and so on. It is better to start with the right definition of domestic violence as many confuse it with marital conflict. A systematic pattern of control through violence is the hallmark of an abusive relationship and it typically follows a three-stage cycle. The first is the 'Tension building stage' where the communication between the partners drastically reduces as the abusive partner stockpiles every little grievance and every disappointment, and the victim develops an awful fear of triggering any angry outbursts. This stage can last for a few hours to a few months. The next is the 'The battering stage' where the abuser, often over a trivial issue bursts out with screaming, hurtful and frightening aggression, dominating and controlling his partner through a number of violent and abusive incidents. Then comes the 'The honeymoon stage': where the abuser cries, feel very sorry that the violence had happened and promises that it will never happen again. This cycle makes the victim stay for long and the abuser to abuse again making the cycle to

A special report by the US Department of Justice says that 1 in 4 women and 1 in 9 men experience severe intimate partner violence. A global study by the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime says that in the year 2017 alone, 50,000 women worldwide were killed by intimate partners or family members—a figure that translates to 1.3 out of every 100,000 women. Men do face domestic abuse and the dynamics of that abuse is similar, but men may also suffer from shame, embarrassment and social stigma that they are not able to protect themselves. There is also, a fear that they may be falsely arrested and

removed from their homes because of the assumption they must be the perpetrator and not a victim because they are male and strong. Nevertheless, abuse by men against women is the most common form of intimate partner violence because of the patriarchal society that considers men as superior to the fairer sex. One of my colleagues was married to a volatile man, who tried his best to destroy her: her health, her self-esteem, values and her very reason to live. The amazing part is that he could do this so convincingly that she really believed that it was all her fault that her husband was always angry with her and that she deserved the beating. Because of ignorance, many victims of domestic violence leave the abuser only after they have been permanently disfigured, emotionally and physically. And leaving the abuser is the most dangerous phase in an abusive relationship as it is during this phase many victims are killed or maimed for

It seems impossible for such victims who stand out there in stark pain, trapped in hopelessness and despair to forgive their offenders. Brennan Manning says "... forces greater than ourselves can empower us to forgive the wounds inflicted by others." Yes, forgiveness finds its full meaning only on the Cross of Jesus Christ as Jesus alone can empower a victim to forgive. Forgiveness is not about the abuser but it is about the well-being of the victim. Lewis Smedes writes, "To forgive is to set a prisoner free and discover that the prisoner was you." Forgiveness is a wise choice because it sets the mind free from the torment of the past. Since forgiveness, trust, and reconciliation are all different issues, forgiveness should never be forced on a victim. Forgiveness is not about tolerating everything and returning back to the abuser but it is about letting go of the past and the bitterness so that one can immerse in the Presence of God.

My book, "When the Flame Flickers: Emerging from marital Abuse," gives the horrific details of this type of abuse, how the children struggle within closed walls, how the support groups have to respond to an abused person and how an abused person can emerge victorious from the horrible pit that she was living in. It is the duty of every Christian to know in-depth about this issue that breaks families and instills violence in the mind of children and break the silence that surrounds it.

## TIME MANAGEMENT

uman beings have a limited life span and are time-bound. All of us have equal amount of time, but we use it differently; some maximize its usefulness, and some don't. Learning to manage our time wisely and efficiently enables us to live life more productively and wittingly.

We can roughly break down a typical 24-hours day into the following categories: 8 hrs. for sleep, 8 hrs. for work, 3 hrs. for eating, 1 hr. for personal hygiene, 2 hrs. to commute to work, and 2 hours for household errands. But within this time limit we must also find time to pursue other interests and responsibilities such as family, social life, spiritual life, health, and mental development. How people allocate their time depends on their priorities in life, personal philosophy, values and attitudes. There are those with a sturdy sense of time, and there are those without. Every minute and hour spent carelessly and inefficiently will be losing of valued time. Here are nine analogies and categories of people who have trouble with time-management:

- The Rabbit: Chronically late (speeding up last minute)
- 2. The Pack Rat: Hates to throw anything and wastes time
- **3. The Ostrich:** Sticks head in the sand, hoping that the problem will disappear
- **4.** The Dog: Overeager and Hyper (I'll do it! Let me do it!)
- The Snake: A scorekeeper of others (can't' close eyes), but cannot see its own tail (a time waster)
- **6. Road Runner:** Gets things in hurry. Often runs into crisis
- **7.** Race Horse: Gets things in a hurry and asks others to help.

- **8. New Pup:** Pleasing people is the first order of business, not spending time on tasks
- Tom Cat: Likes to be left alone and set one's own timeframes for getting jobs finished. Is independent, and has little awareness of time.

You must have found yourself in one of the above categories, I suppose. If you have a problem with time-management, here are some practical guidelines:

- Make a list of everything you need to do on a given day or a week. Create a day-by-day and hour-by-hour list
- 2. Prioritize your list based on deadlines. Follow the principle, "first things first."
- 3. Divide your priorities into manageable parts
- 4. Tackle difficult tasks when you are most alert
- Delegate as many chores as you can to others appropriately, such as family members
- 6. Stay away from procrastination
- 7. Develop a routine
- 8. Eliminate possible distractions such as ringing of telephones
- Save time whenever, and whichever way possible (online payment, planning ahead for grocery shopping, and multitasking)
- 10. Schedule breaks in between tasks and take adequate time for rest and sleep.

Time-management is a skill learned. Practice the skill daily to make it a creative habit, and you will be able to accomplish much in life that matters most.



## **TALKING TRUTH**

#### **HOW TO PREPARE & PRESENT GOSPEL TALKS**

#### **SUB-HEADINGS**

- 1. Sub headings serve two basic functions. (a) They support the main heading above them in the same way the main heading support the proposition. (b) They carry all the supporting material for the speech e.g. Testimony Facts and figures Illustrations Comparisons and contrasts
- 2. The following points should be noted: (a) Follow all rules as above for main headings except that sub headings support main headings and not the proposition. (b) They should contain the speaker's personal language. Echo the words of the speech in the sub-headings, and other parts of the outline. (c) There must be at least two sub-headings but do not have too many as they become hard to follow.

#### CONCLUSION

- 1. This serves two purposes: (a) To bring the speech to a well crafted close. (b) To crystallize or set the desired response in the hearer's mind.
- 2. The following points should be noted: (a) Use sufficient sentences to achieve the purposes. One sentence for each point as for the introduction (b) Do not stop abruptly round off your speech (c) Close with a quote, illustration, summary or exhortation (d) Never leave the lectern without making the audience realize that there is something for them to do, say or feel

## PROPOSITIONAL PREACHING Constructing the Sermon SESSION 1

Preaching is an intensely personal art. Every man with a soul on fire, and a message to deliver, will have his own way of presenting the truth. Preaching should be the enthusiastic and joyous utterance of a living experience. To the extent that it is so difficult to confine it within rules.

**TECHNIQUE** Like every other art, however, preaching has a technique, the knowledge of which helps to clarify expression and correct faults of workmanship. The musician studies the rules of expression and harmony; the painter studies the mechanism of his art--the composition of paints, the making of brushes and the forms he is to portray. So, too, does the preacher need to study the art of sermon construction, the psychology of an audience and the principles of delivery.

We have emphasized the value of an outline, and

have studied the place and value of the theme. We are now going to study more definitively the construction of sermon divisions.

An outline consists of main headings, subheadings, and perhaps further which we may identify as subsubheadings.

**VALUE OF OUTLINE** So, you have chosen your subject - what then? How do you best present it to the congregation? It is important to have an outline, to keep your thoughts in order. It is a pity when a sermon lacks coherence or plan. Good ideas can be lost by the hearer, interesting illustrations may fail to admit the light, and good vocabulary may seem pointless, all because the sermon followed no principle of construction. A good outline gives order and sequence to the thoughts presented.

The outline of the sermon is what the skeleton is to the body. A skeleton is not of much value by itself, but when it is covered by living tissue it is of tremendous importance.

A sermon outline does two things at least: 1. It is of great help to the preacher in thinking through his subject. 2. It helps the people to understand and remember the message.

The arrangement of our thoughts in an outline is one of the best means of accomplishing that end. An outline not only helps the preacher to clarify his thought; it helps him to develop thinking. It is a creative process.

QUESTION THE TEXT You have been attracted by a text. You sense its value and truth. But how can you amplify its statement, illustrate its truth, and discover enough material to occupy the time for a sermon? One of the first lessons I ever learned was to question the text. Ask: "Who? What? Why? Where? When? How?" Remember in our session on Introduction to structure this question is call the interrogative.

Take, for instance, a text like Rom. 4:3b: "Abraham believed God, and it was reckoned unto him for righteousness." To answer those questions about this text you will be obliged to go both to the context in Rom. 4, and to the story of Abraham in Genesis. When you have read those passages carefully and thoughtfully, and have answered the questions, you will have quite a lot of information concerning a man's history, and an important doctrine.

### India's Christian Auto Raja

Rising from street crime to feeding 700 people daily, Bengaluru's Auto Raja is redefining humanity

From a petty thief to a good Samaritan – T. Raja's life underwent a transformation when he realised that true happiness comes from helping others. He started the Home of Hope 20 years ago to rescue, shelter and feed the destitute.

Every time we step out of our comfortable homes, we see children and adults begging to make ends meet. Many turn their heads away, some spare a little change but only a few actually try to spend some time to listen to them and lend a hand. One of them is T. Raja, 49, who strongly believes, "We should not wait for another Mother Teresa to come from a foreign country; we should help each other in times of need."

#### From rogue to saviour

Raja began stealing, drinking and gambling from an early age. When he stole from his family, they disowned him and kicked him out. He lived on the streets for two years like a beggar, sleeping on the pavement, among garbage bins and rabid dogs that constantly whined around him. He moved from Bengaluru

to Chennai and continued his old ways. He got caught for his crimes, and was sent to jail. It was during this time that he began seeking the purpose of his life.

After leaving prison, Raja came back to Bengaluru and asked his family to help him build a new life. He began driving autorickshaws and taxis to support himself. He even worked as a bodyguard to the autorickshaw union leader.

He had found his purpose and this realisation led to the formation of the New Ark Mission of India (NAMI) with the aim of helping the dying and destitute.

#### Lending a helping hand

Raja started NAMI in 1997. His first rescue was a lady from SP road, half naked, covered in fleas with maggots chewing on two of her toes. He got her home in his auto and from there began his journey. He would pick up the destitute from the streets and bring them home in his auto. He would then shave, bathe and clean their wounds, provide them with new clothes and a filling meal. Thus, NAMI began functioning in a 5' x 6ft passageway outside Raja's single room house.

"It's not easy approaching the destitute. Passers-by suspect me of luring these people into hospitals and stealing their organs. The destitute are taken aback because they have never been approached by anyone before. In fact, they are only used to people throwing stones at them, and abusing them," says Raja.

"Some are so weak that they can barely move. Those who manage to, have to compete with street dogs over leftovers in the trash. Most of them, rejected by their families, are living the most inhumane lives. When I come across such people, I bring them to the Home of Hope, a hospice under NAMI."

Born out of compassion and empathy, this home now feeds 700 people, three meals a day. It provides medical care, shelter and education to homeless and destitute children. It survives on donations from the public and gets no support from the government.

#### **Water woes**

The biggest problem faced by Raja right now is the unavailability of water at the Home of Hope. He spends approximately Rs. 40,000 to Rs. 50,000 a month to buy water.

"While reading a newspaper article a few weeks ago, I learnt about the water woes faced by the Home of Hope; and the exorbitant amounts spent on procuring water. I wanted to try and help, and met Raja to discuss this issue. At the meeting, he told me that the borewell at the home was drying up and he had been buying water from tankers by paying a huge sum every month. I realised that the need of the hour was to resolve the water issue", says Reji Koshy, 45, Consultant for Real Estate and Photography.

Reji started a donation drive called 'The Water Project' hoping to raise money through crowdfunding to help solve the water problem by helping HOH dig a new borewell in a property near a lake.

Once the water problem gets resolved, NAMI plans on expanding its reach to ensure that there are no more destitute on the streets of India. "It gives me immense purpose and joy to help the needy and see them happy. Their happiness gives me the strength to face the obstacles in the journey ahead", says Raja.

She said in her speech that her stint in politics led to depression, which went to the extent of attempting suicide. These instances apparently gave her a chance to read the Bible, which brought about change in her life.

All her problems, she said, started fading away one by one after she accepted Jesus Christ as her personal Savior.

### Nagma Interview, About Her Faith And Mission on Christianity

Actress Nagma is a Christian now.

She ruled the roost in Tamil, Telugu and Hindi films from 1993 to 1997.

She is now almost in retirement. While he younger sister Jyothika is happily married with Actor Surya with a kid, Nagma has so far not entered into matrimony.

I was born on Christmas to a Muslim mother and a Hindu father. I went to a convent school from childhood. I was exposed to Christianity from a young age. I went to Mount Mary Convent School in Bandra, Mumbai. There, Mass was a routine feature. I always thought I am very special to God because I was born on Dec 25th – perhaps because the world celebrated the day.

While reading the New Testament, I realized the importance of baptism and also of joining a church. Therefore, I immediately joined Pastor Shekhar Kalyanpur's New Life Fellowship in Juhu, Mumbai. I took baptism on Jan 4. Since 2007 was a year of rest I decided to take a break from films and continued my Bible study fervently.



## The Easter egg represents the "new life," or the resurrection of Jesus Christ. Here's more...

Easter, also called Pascha (Greek, Latin) or Resurrection Sunday, is a celebration and occasion praising the resurrection of Jesus from the dead, portrayed in the New Testament as having happened on the third day after his burial following His torturous crucifixion by the Romans at Calvary in 30 AD.

Here is some interesting trivia about this Holy day.

- 1. The feast day of Easter was originally a pagan celebration of renewal and rebirth. It was celebrated in early spring and it honored the pagan Saxon goddess Eastre. When the early missionaries converted the Saxons (early British, Germans and Dutch) to Christianity, the holiday, since it fell around the same time as the traditional memorial of Christ's resurrection from the dead, was merged with the pagan celebration, and this became known as Easter.
- 2. After Halloween, Easter is the top-selling candy holiday after Halloween.
- 3. The Easter egg represents the "new life," or the resurrection of Jesus Christ.
- 4. Easter eggs were first colored red, in memory of the blood Jesus shed during his crucifixion.
- 5. So how did the rabbit or Easter Bunny come into the picture? Again this has to do with the Goddess Eastre. Legend has it that following a long winter, the goddess of spring, Eastre, turned a frozen bird into a snow hare that could lay colorful eggs.

#### Reflection:

The foundation of the Christianity rests on the resurrection of Jesus from the dead. If there was no resurrection, Christianity could be called a hoax, and we are wasting our time. But the truth



is, the event of Jesus' resurrection cannot be denied. The world-famous historian, Professor Thomas Arnold of Rugby, once said that Christ's resurrection from the dead is the "best-attested fact in human history".


cent of his earnings. A lack of fixed working hours also led to erratic income.

adopted 3 Chinese children, two of whom had brain tumors.

- 6. He played basketball in college, but took up acting after injuring his foot.
- 7. He has worked as a waiter and did some modeling for The Gap early in his career.
- 8. Was seriously considered for the lead role in Superman Returns (2006). The part went to Brandon Routh because the director felt he was too popular after playing Jesus.

## Welterweight world champion Manny Pacquiao: 'I changed when I heard the voice of God'

The welterweight world champion has left his womanising ways behind him and he has refocused on boxing and religion.

It is disconcerting to stand a foot away from Manny Pacquiao's soft brown eyes – which are no more than a couple of feet from his hard brown fists – and hear him say, without any apparent duplicity, that God has spoken to him personally, how he has seen "the end of time". It would be unsettling coming from anyone. From Manny, who has boxed for a living for nearly two decades, it is tempting to wonder if he has taken one punch too many. He is, after all, not a dreamer, does not claim to be a charismatic or a prophet, and it would be a major shock

had he ingested any hallucinogenic substance. He lives a particularly corporeal existence.

Nor does he claim, as some fighters have, that God is on his side. God is just, well, not as far away as he once imagined, certainly not when he was cutting loose in any nightspot that would let him in, from Manila to Los Angeles. "I have a lot of dreams and visions," the world welterweight champion says in a voice as unthreatening as a mother's whisper. "I even heard the voice of God. When I heard the voice of God, I am trembling and melting. I feel I have died. It was an amazing, amazing experience.

"I'm happy because I found the right way, salvation, born again. We are required to be born again, all of us. Christ said unless we are born again we cannot enter the kingdom of God. So it's very important to me. Jesus Christ said: 'I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.' There is no other way. The only way is through Jesus."



Pacquiao once was not so righteous. He once was an allnight hound dog, taking his pleasure where he pleased, ignoring all advice to respect the sanctity of his marriage vows and determined to squeeze as much fun from life as was available to someone who was born into grinding poverty. Those were his hardcore inclinations until only a few years ago.

Here is a snapshot of that life, from the opening of Gary Andrew Poole's excellent biography on him. "As Manny 'Pacman' Pacquiao saunters out of the locker room at the Wild Card Boxing Club in Hollywood, California, he holds out his hand, and a member of his entourage slaps a comb in it. Looking in one of the gym's many grimy mirrors, Pacquiao combs his jet-black hair, brushes off his goatee and nods his head in self-approval. Someone slips on his watch – a gold Rolex Yacht Master – and then gives him his diamond stud earring, which he puts in his left ear." Dressed to kill the ladies – long before he had that conversation with God.

The hair is still black. The goatee and the diamond stud are in place, too. The eyes are just as knowing, but he is profoundly a different man, more content, less restless. He is a congressman now, too, serving his people while dealing out pain in his other job. "People are surprised by the way I have changed my life," he says. "All the running around. In that time and age, I knew I could do whatever I wanted. But I changed when I heard the voice of God, and I

can testify that there is a God. I saw two angels, white, long, big wings. I saw Paradise. God showed me about the end of time. This all happened within the last three years. That's how I changed my life."

I do not have the feeling I am in the presence of a man who could put me in hospital with a practised flick of his fist, who did exactly that inside two rounds in 2009 to Ricky Hatton, another fighter who did not stint on life's pleasures, and is again struggling with those temptations. Pacquiao's trainer of 13 years, Freddie Roach, is standing a few feet away. He has heard Manny's story of redemption many times. "It's more vital to him now than ever before," Roach says. "He was born a Catholic, now he's a born-again Christian. His mother [Dionesia] hates it. She's always trying to force the Rosary on him. The only worry about it is that maybe it could hurt his political career, because 90% of the Philippines is Catholic and he's a born-again Christian."

Roach continues: "There is this other side to him, though. He's very different to a lot of boxers. He always is keeping busy, like playing basketball in the village and so forth, but he discusses the Bible when we're flying somewhere, asking what does this really mean, what does that really mean. I listen. Sometimes it's quite funny. Sometimes it makes sense. But sometimes it can be a long trip. There's good and bad. Religion means a lot to him, but he has done stuff that's not so religious, so ...

"Some fighters turn to religion, because it's a tough business. I'm not a religious person so it's not a factor for me. I grew up a Catholic until the second grade. I got to my first Holy Communion, but I didn't make it to Confirmation. They'd lost me by then. But it's a tough life, boxing. Fighters are often looking for something they can hold on to. Maybe that's why he's done it – and more now than ever he needs it.

"He and his wife [Jinkee] are happier than ever. He doesn't party any more, doesn't drink anymore. He's a clean liver, doesn't fuck around with girls no more. And his wife is very happy about that. He's a better family man. So there's a lot of good that goes with it. He was a pretty wild guy, had the world by the balls. Everything was available."


